Manufacturers located in Kent and Medway generate an estimated £3.2bn GVA to the UK economy a year. World leading businesses such as beauty and skincare brand Coty and defence, security and aerospace manufacturing company BAE Systems are among the makers already here.

In all, over **3,400 manufacturing companies** are based in the Kent and Medway region, **employing over 45,000 people.** Other international brands that have made their home in Kent include, Bose, Jazz Pharmaceuticals, Rolex, Veetee, Sleepeezee, Hornby and Qinetiq. Brompton Bicycles are set to join them in 2028.

Kent is home to a diverse manufacturing base, **from specialised SMEs to leading innovators** in sectors like aerospace, defence, healthcare, and med-tech. The region is also investing in green technologies and renewable energy to support the UK's low-carbon transition.






